All financial obligations must be cleared before leaving.

MANDATORY TB ASSESSMENT FOR ALL VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers must have a current clear TB assessment within the last 4 years if you will have ongoing, frequent or prolonged contact with students. One-day volunteers may be exempt. (Ed. Code 49406(m)). TB Assessment forms must be filled out in front of a Nurse or Physician. There are several CLINICS scheduled @ Granite Ridge.
