Cost Breakdown

There are never any “per student” fees; all costs for individual team members are assumed by the team as a group.

New teams can expect to pay approximately \$800 for team registration (which includes the Challenge Set), and a robot kit of parts. Additional costs for event participation, travel, food, team shirts and other optional items will vary. Veteran teams will pay less since the robot set can be used year after year. Team registration must be purchased every season.

- ~\$500 for the EV3 LEGO Robotics platform. This is the robot kit, including software and parts to build and program your robot. This can be purchased separately or during team registration.
- ~\$80 to build a 4'x8' game table for the Robot Game. Specifications are at gocvr.org/fl-build
- A computer for programming (Windows or Mac). Price varies and not included in the registration fee.

Annual Fees

- \$300 for National Registration Fee and includes field kit/challenge set (Contains mat and models for the Robot Game)
- \$85 Event Registration Fee (Central Valley Robotics Events)
